

(E) Breton Numerals (1/1) [Solution]

E1.

- a. pevar-ugent ÷ pemp = **c’hwezek** (80 ÷ 5 = 16)
- b. pemp ha hanter kant – daouzek = **tri ha daou-ugent** (55 – 12 = 43)
- c. nav warn ugent + **pevarzek** = tri ha daou-ugent (29 + 14 = 43)
- d. kant ÷ **ugent** = pemp (100 ÷ 20 = 5)

(b) daoulagad

Some languages have “dual”-style plurals for objects which occur in nature in pairs (such as eyes, ears, etc.), and thus the plural for “eyes” in Breton contains the element daou (2).
